WHAT IS **Prayer in Every City?**

Who can participate?

This movement is designed for **united prayer** among believers. A group should have at least two participants.

What do we pray about?

Revival and Spiritual Awakening in our communities, churches, towns, colleges, schools and nation.

When should we pray?

As often as you would like to meet. Some groups will choose to meet once a week, some will meet bi-weekly and others will meet once a month.

Where should we pray?

In your homes, churches, schools or at work. You may even wish to try a conference call prayer meeting.

Why is united prayer important?

Jesus said that where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them. There is power in **united prayer**.

How should we pray?

Follow the Holy Spirit's lead. This suggested prayer guide is designed to help you pray, if the Lord so leads you to use it. You may also pray scripture back to the Lord. Please visit our blog for more help on how to pray.

"Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them"
(Matt. 18:18-20).

How to Begin Your Prayer Session

Begin your prayer time with praise to the Lord and confession of all known sin.

Praise

When Jesus taught the disciples to pray in Matthew 6:9-13, he began by praising God. Begin your prayer time by praising God through a praise song, hymn, reading a Psalm or calling out His names:

Adonai – My Great Lord

Elohim – The All-Powerful One

El Roi – The God who sees

Jehovah – "I AM," The Self-Existent One

Jehovah-Rapha – The Lord who heals

Jehovah-Rohi – the Lord is my Shepherd

Confession

Even as Christians, sin can prevent our prayers from being answered. Psalms 66:18 says, "If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me".

Make a list of all your sins and confess them to the Lord. Even the sins that we consider small, such as the sins listed below, can prevent our prayers from being answered.
