Key Words – formerly, walk, flesh, grace

1. Ephesians 2:1 trespasses - *paraptōma*—a *side-slip (lapse or deviation)*, i.e. (unintentional) *error* or (willful) *transgression* :- fall, fault, offence, sin, trespass.—Strong's Talking Greek & Hebrew Dictionary
 - a. Sins – means offence
2. Ephesians 2:2 – we see the word *formerly*. This word appears 4 times in chapter 2.

- a. Who is the prince of the power of the air?
3. Eph. 2:4 Greek word for mercy - *eleos*— *compassion* —Strong's Talking Greek & Hebrew Dictionary
4. Eph. 2:5 word transgressions used as synonym for sin means same as trespasses in verse 1
5. Eph. 2:6 Greek word for seated
 - a. Seated -*synkathizō*—to *give (or take) a seat* in company *with* :- (make) sit (down) together.—
 - b. Aorist tense – usually denotes a simple act occurring in past time.
 - c. Read 1:20-23
 - d. Eph. 1:20 which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places...
 - e. Also see the repeated phrase *in Christ Jesus* appears 4 times
6. Eph. 2:8-10 salvation
 - a. Greek word for Grace- *charis*—*graciousness (as gratifying)*, of manner or act (abstract or concrete; literal, figurative or spiritual; especially the divine influence upon the heart, and its reflection in the life; including *gratitude*) :- acceptable, benefit, favour, gift, grace (-ious), joy, liberality, pleasure, thank (-s, -worthy).—Strong's Talking Greek & Hebrew Dictionary
 - b. Definition for Faith given in Hebrews 1:1- = Now faith is the assurance of *things* hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Heb 11:1 (NASB)
 - c. Salvation is a gift and can't be earned
 - d. V. 10 Are we doing our works or God's works?
7. Eph. 2:15 enmity is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances
